ABOUT HARRAH'S HOOSIER PARK

BACKSTRETCH INFORMATION

The backstretch at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino offers a full range of business and hospitality amenities that include a track kitchen, tack shop, horsemen's lounge, dormitories, restrooms, locker rooms, and shower facilities.

Dormitory room contracts are issued by the Dormitory Supervisor, Teena Walden, at (765) 609-4834.

The backstretch kitchen, The Horseshoe Café, is available for breakfast, specials, and short orders from early morning to the last race of the night during live racing. The facility closes after training hours on Monday and is closed all day on Sunday. To reach The Backstretch Kitchen call (765) 609-4844.

Midwest Harness Supply (MHS) is located just outside the racing office on the backside and provides high quality horse supplies. MHS is open both during the racing and off season.

SHIP-IN INFORMATION

When shipping into Harrah's Hoosier Park, you must provide the following mandatory documents at the security gate :

- A current coggins dated within the past 12 months
- Proof of equine herpes vaccination dated within the past six months
- A health certification dated within 30 days if shipping in from out-of state

Health papers will not be written at the gate for incoming horses.

Harrah's Hoosier Park will designate two barns on the backside exclusively for horses shipping in for the Breeders Crown eliminations and races. Ship-ins staying multiple nights must make arrangements by contacting the race office at (765) 609-4880, (765) 609-4881, or (765) 609-4869.

LICENSE INFORMATION

All backside personnel must be licensed by the Indiana Horse Racing Commission (IHRC) and only licensed personnel and authorized persons will be allowed in the stable or paddock area. A license application can be obtained using the following options: Online, via email/fax, or you can visit the licensing office. IHRC licensing staff are available via phone or e-mail to assist racing participants seeking information or application forms. Due to health and safety restrictions, participants are strongly encouraged to apply for a license prior to visiting the track licensing office by using one of the three processes described.

You can access the commission's online license process by visiting <http://www.in.gov/hrc/2334.htm> (Tip – do not use Internet Explorer). When choosing the online licensing option, if you already have an account you need only to login, however, if you need to set up an account please click on "need to register" at the bottom of the box. Clicking this box will guide you through the process of setting up a user profile account. Please note this account is an individual user account, meaning multiple people cannot utilize the same account. When setting up your account it will ask for your IHRC license number. If you were licensed in Indiana previously, you are renewing a license and you already have an IHRC number. This is indicated on an IHRC issued photo ID badge or indicated on a receipt given by the IHRC. If you need help locating this number, please call one of our licensing offices – IHRC staff are happy to assist you. When you register for an account you will verify your email, and then you will begin the licensing application process. Upon completion of your application, you will be given an option to pay with your credit card (Visa/MasterCard/Discover). Once your payment is made and your application has been submitted, an IHRC review will begin. Please note this process could take up to 3 business days to complete depending on submission date; possibly longer if additional information is required.

If the online process is not for you we have the licensing forms on our website at <https://www.in.gov/hrc/licensing/>. Once your application is completed you can scan and email your application to INHors racing@hrc.in.gov or you can fax it to (765) 683-2568. Upon our receipt of your application, an IHRC staff member will contact you regarding payment options over the phone or you may mail in your payment via U.S. mail or overnight.

LICENSE INFORMATION CONTINUED

When visiting the licensing office at Hoosier Park, paper applications will be available outside the office. In an effort to continue to serve our horse racing participants while at the same time aid in the safety and health of our employees and visiting public, the IHRC has implemented the following process. Masks are required to gain access to the lobby area which has been limited to 3 individuals at a time. Due to limited access, the IHRC requires you to have your paper application completed prior to your arrival. When visiting the office, please be mindful of the limited access and social distancing requirements which can result in significant wait times.

DETENTION AND POST TIMES

Prior to the lucrative Breeders Crown finals, eliminations for these prestigious contests will occur on Friday, Oct. 23 and Saturday, Oct. 24 with a post time of approximately 6:30 pm EDT each evening.

Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino, in conjunction with the Hambletonian Society, has determined all horses competing in these races must be present on the grounds for a 24-hour detention period. For both the eliminations and the finals, Harrah's Hoosier Park will provide two detention check-in times, one at 7 pm and one at 8 pm, depending upon which race the respective horse is competing. Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing Office staff will inform horsemen of which time applies to them.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Horsemen should check the weekly condition sheet as Harrah's Hoosier Park will host races for those horses that did not make the Breeders Crown finals.
- Salix (Furosemide) reporting time is 4 hours and 15 minutes prior to the scheduled post time.
- Salix will be administered in the horse's assigned stall in the paddock at the designated time. A full salix schedule can be found on Harrah's Hoosier Park's website - www.HarrahsHoosierPark.com.

HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

TEAM MEMBERS

- Prior to reporting to work all team members are required to take and pass a health evaluation.
- All Team Members will be required to wear masks and temperatures will be checked before each shift.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be conveniently located for frequent use.
- All team members will be trained on proper cleaning and disinfecting protocols and informed of proper PPE requirements.
- Team members who are unwell or symptomatic will be directed to stay home.
- Work areas and common areas have been rearranged to facilitate proper social distancing.

GUESTS

- All guests will be required to have their temperature checked before entering the casino.
- Our team will be frequently cleaning high-touch areas throughout the property.
- Signage and floor markers will be placed throughout the property to clearly indicate social distancing measures.
- In addition to our designated non-smoking areas on our Casino floor, smoking will not be permitted at any Table Games.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be placed frequently around the property.

WEAR MASKS

- Guests must have a mask on at all times, and maintain appropriate social distancing.
- Masks may be pulled down when seated at a restaurant/bar while actively eating or drinking. Eating or drinking is only allowed when seated at a restaurant, bar or slot machine.
- Masks may be pulled down when smoking, and smoking is only allowed when seated at a slot machine or betting carrel in a designated smoking area.

SPECTATOR RACING

- Pari-mutuel teller windows and self-service betting machines will be arranged to allow for proper social distancing.
- The Pegasus Lounge and Simulcast Area near the Grandstands will be non-smoking.
- Smoking will be permitted outside in The Yard and in the designated smoking areas on Trackside.
- Dining amenities will be arranged to allow for proper social distancing.
- The Grandstands will be marked for social distancing, and the Terrace Showroom Suites will be temporarily unavailable.
- All machines and chairs will be frequently cleaned and disinfected.
- Guests will be encouraged to use sanitizing stations and practice frequent hand washing.

HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

BACKSIDE

- All horsemen are required to have their temperatures checked before entering the backside and will not be permitted with a temperature greater than 100.4.
- Masks must be worn at all times, covering both the mouth and the nose.

GENERAL EVENT INFORMATION

Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino will host the 2020 Breeders Crown on Friday, October 30 & Saturday, October 31 with limited spectators, in accordance with the approved health and safety plan for the event.

The 2020 Breeders Crown event, presented by The Libfeld-Katz Breeding Partnership, will be hosted within the walls of the racing building and consists of three event spaces totaling approved indoor capacity:

- Breeders Crown Owners & Sponsors Experience – Located in the Homestretch Dining Area, Lower Level Grandstands, and Terrace Showroom Suites
- Breeders Crown Grandstands Experience – Located in the Terrace Showroom Grandstand Seating
- Breeders Crown Simulcast Center Experience – Located in the State-of-the-Art Simulcast Center

The initial availability of Breeders Crown experience packages will be extended for purchase by invitation to members of the Hambletonian Society, Breeders Crown horse owners, event sponsors, and local racing community.

RESERVATIONS FOR OWNERS

Reservations are based on limited availability, and not guaranteed. Owners anticipating Breeders Crown entries may sign-up for the Breeders Crown Owners reservation waitlist by emailing BreedersCrown2020@gmail.com, and final reservations will require a Breeders Crown entry. Reservations for the Breeders Crown Owners & Sponsors Experience will be available in tables of four for \$400 or six for \$600 each night.

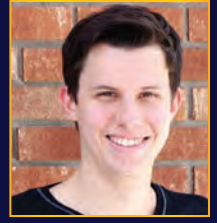
