FOX VALLEY TOPAZ was the victim of excess cover, swung wide turning for home from a no chance spot and swept the field to take all the money. TWIST N CLOUT fired out to the front, yielded for the pocket trip, ducked up the inside when clear with trot but was nailed late at big odds. RACING STAR raced second over at the half, followed a fourth over flow, angled wide and was outfinished late. WARRAWEE KAY set it up second over, tipped wide with open road and failed to fire. NOTJUSTAPRETTYFACE trailed the field, saved ground, negotiated traffic through the lane with steady trot but was blocked towards the inside. BREAK THE NEWS brushed from out of third to take the lead before the half, set the fractions and folded in the stretch. HAWAIIAN DRINK pulled uncovered at the half, followed a third over flow going to three quarters but failed to rally and threw in a clunker. SPECIAL SWEETHEART left and tucked in the pocket turn one, got pushed back to third, pulled uncovered going to three quarters and folded in the lane. GINGER AND FRED was blocked on the rail with no place to pace, searched for a seam but never got clear. THOU SHALT NOT was parked out at the back and had no chance.
