
ABUCKABETT HANOVER (Betting Line-All Tucked Up-Western Ideal)



Went off stride and finished 10th in the Breeders Crown final at age 2. Won multiple starts on the Grand Circuit last season, including divisions of the Champlain and Nassagaweya stakes in Canada. This year, his top triumphs have been the Tattersalls Pace and Simcoe Stakes. Trained by Tony Alagna. Owned by Crawford Farms Racing (Michelle and Al Crawford), Alagna Racing, Jablonsky Held Stable (Bridgette Jablonsky and Steven Held), and Barbera N Wienick Stable (Joseph Barbera and Steven Wienick). Bred by Hanover Shoe Farms, which is tied with Brittany Farms for the most Breeders Crown trophies by a breeder with 27.

CHARLIE MAY (McArdle-Stipple Hanover-Western Hanover)



Did not race in the Breeders Crown at 2. Charlie May was voted Ohio's best 2-year-old male pacer in 2020. His wins last season included the Ohio Sire Stakes championship, which he won with a track-record 1:50.2 performance at Scioto Downs. This year, he won the Carl Milstein Memorial at Northfield in a world-record 1:48.4. His other wins include a division of the Bluegrass Stakes. He was second in the Messenger Stakes and Ohio Sire Stakes championship. He was first across in the finish line in the Meadowlands Pace but placed ninth for interference. Trained by Steve Carter. Owned by Don Tiger. Bred by Don Tiger. He was the first horse Tiger ever bred. When the time arrived for Tiger to name the horse, his wife, April, suggested Charlie. Too basic, Tiger replied. Not that it mattered, Tiger continued, because the horse wasn't going to turn out to be much anyway. "You never know," April said. "Charlie may become a superstar." So, the horse was named Charlie May.

CHASE H HANOVER (Captaintreacherous-Calgary Hanover-Western Ideal)



Did not race in the Breeders Crown at 2. Last year, he equaled the world record (1:51.1) for a 2-year-old gelding pacer on a half-mile track when he won the Standardbred Stakes at the Delaware County Fairgrounds in Ohio. He finished second to Southwind Gendry in the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes championship for 2-year-old male pacers. His victories this year include the Jenna's Beach Boy Stakes. He was third in the Messenger Stakes. His sire Captaintreacherous won a Breeders Crown at age 3 in 2013. His dam Calgary Hanover was a Breeders Crown champion at age 2 in 2006. Trained by Scott Cox. Owned by Jason Ash and Scott Cox. Bred by Hanover Shoe Farms, which is tied with Brittany Farms for the most Breeders Crown trophies by a breeder with 27.

HEART OF CHEWBACCA (Bring On The Beach-JT's Chewbacca-Four Starzzz Shark)




Did not race in the Breeders Crown at 2. Last year, he was runner-up to Charlie May in the Ohio Sire Stakes championship. His 10 career wins have come in Ohio, with nine in stakes for Ohio-sired horses. Trained by Christi Noble. Owned by Dennis Owens and Norman Rae Racing (Dan Noble). Bred by Spring Haven Farm.

I'LL DRINK TO THAT (American Ideal-Margarita Monday-Ponder)



Did not race in the Breeders Crown at 2. Picked up a win at age 2 on the New York Sire Stakes circuit. His wins this season include the New York Sire Stakes championship and a division of the Empire Breeders Classic. He was second in his elimination of the Little Brown Jug and fourth in the final. Trained by Chris Ryder. Owned by Craig Henderson, Lawrence Minowitz, Bob Mondillo, and Oompa's Farm (Peter Mazzella). Bred by Winbak Farm.

PERFECT STING (Always B Miki-Shebestingin-Bettor's Delight)



Dan Patch Award for best 2-year-old male pacer in 2020 when he was unbeaten in 10 races. Breeders Crown winner at 2, in a dead heat with Summa Cum Laude, the first dead heat for win in Breeders Crown history. He is the only 2-year-old male pacer to ever win a Breeders Crown as part of an undefeated season. Attempting to become first male pacer to win Breeders Crown trophies at 2 and 3 since Artiscape in 1997-98. His eight second-place finishes this year include six in races worth more than \$275,000: North America Cup, Meadowlands Pace, Tattersalls, Little Brown Jug, Hempt Memorial, and Cane Pace. Trained by Joe Holloway, who trained sire Always B Miki at ages 2 and 3 and dam Shebestingin throughout her career. Bred and owned by Brittany Farms (George Segal) and Val D'Or Farms (Martin Granoff). Brittany Farms leads all owners in Crown history with 20 trophies.

ROCKYROAD HANOVER (Captaintreacherous-Romantic Moment-American Ideal)



Did not race in the Breeders Crown at 2. His wins this year include the Cane Pace, the second jewel in the Pacing Triple Crown, which he captured in a lifetime-best 1:48.1. He finished second in the Adios and a division of the Bluegrass Stakes. His sire Captaintreacherous won a Breeders Crown at age 3 in 2013. Trained by Tony Alagna. Owned by Stephanie and Myron Bell's Riverview Racing, Brad Grant, Ken Jacobs, and Plouffe Head and VJ Stable (Daniel Plouffe, Steven Head, Vincent and Joseph Barbera). Bred by Hanover Shoe Farms, which is tied with Brittany Farms for the most Breeders Crown trophies by a breeder with 27.

SOUTHWIND GENDRY (Always B Miki-Gambler's Passion-Cam's Card Shark)



Finished third, beaten a head, in the Breeders Crown final at age 2. His wins last season included the Matron Stakes, Elevation, and Pennsylvania Sire Stakes championship. His victories this year include a division of the Bluegrass Stakes and an elimination of the Meadowlands Pace. He was fourth-placed-third in the Meadowlands Pace final. He also was third in the Tattersalls Pace. His sire Always B Miki was a two-time Breeders Crown Open Pace champion. Trained by Ron Burke. Owned by Burke Racing Stable, Phil Collura, Knox Services (Carolyn Brechler), and J&T Silva-Purnel & Libby (Jerry and Theresa Silva-Purnel and Elizabeth Jones). Bred by Southwind Farms.

SOUTHWIND PETYR (American Ideal-Southwind Paris-Sportswriter)



Finished seventh in his Breeders Crown elimination at 2 and did not advance to the final. Picked up a win on the New York Sire Stakes circuit last year and was second to Southwind Gendry in the Matron Stakes and a division of the International Stallion Stakes. This season, he finished second in a division of the Empire Breeders Classic and two legs of the New York Sire Stakes. Trained by Mark Harder. Owned by Rick Phillips and Mark Harder. Bred by Southwind Farms.

WATER SPORTS TEEN (Somebeachsomewhere-Posey Tina-Camluck)



Did not race in the Breeders Crown at 2. His wins this season include a division of the Bluegrass Stakes and his elimination of the Adios. He finished third in the Adios final. He also was third in the Carl Milstein Memorial. His sire Somebeachsomewhere won a Breeders Crown at age 3 in 2008 and was Horse of the Year. Trained by Jennifer Bongiorno. Owned by Joshua Graber. Bred by Robert Key.
